



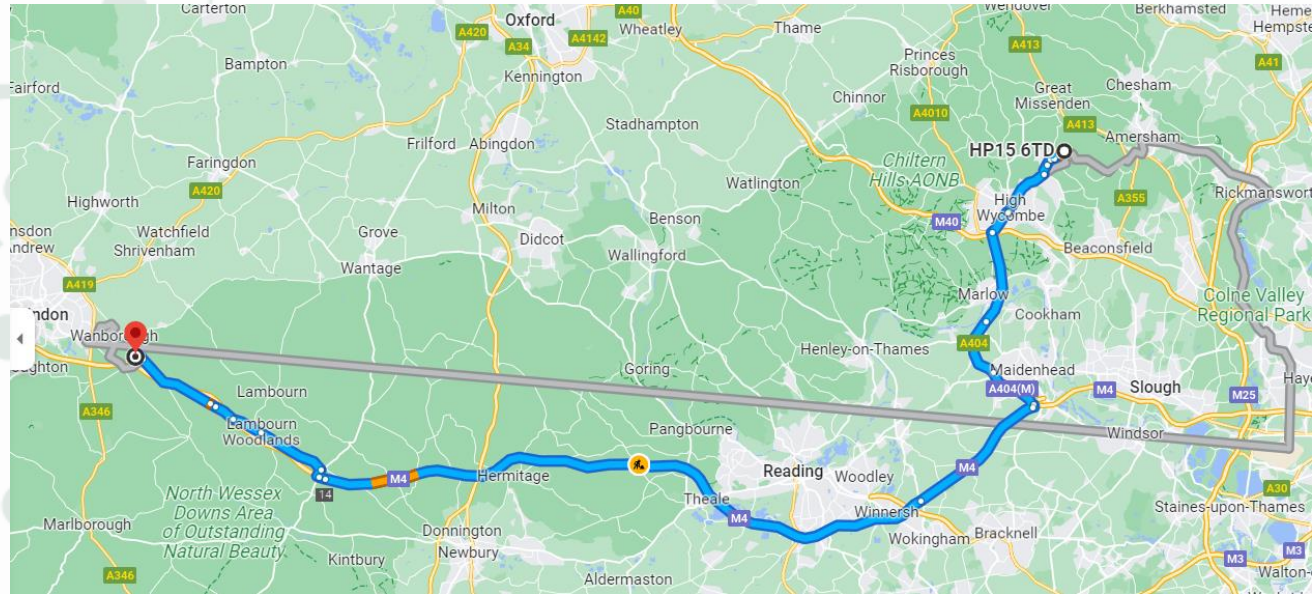

Health and safety

- All staff are DBS checked
- All staff wear name badges and a uniform
- All staff are trained in and capable of handling emergency situations
- Staff are available 24 hours a day to assist with emergencies
- The contained site is very secure, with an electric gate at the front, high fences on the perimeter of the property and CCTV cameras throughout.

Health and safety

- To avoid any sickness outbreaks, please do not send your child if anyone in your family is ill 48 hours before the event.
- If a child is sick at any stage during the week, we will need to send them home. This includes one off sicknesses. Children can return 48 hours later if they can.
- Before the trip, you and your child will be asked to sign a code of conduct.

Accommodation

- Each en-suite room will sleep about 4 children.
- Teachers will be in rooms close by so as to supervise and oversee the children.
- Bedding is not provided. Children will need to bring a sleeping bag and a pillow.
- A kit list will be sent out by the Easter break 2026.
- Children will be given the chance to choose who they would like to be in the same room as. They will not be told who they are sharing with until they arrive at PGL.

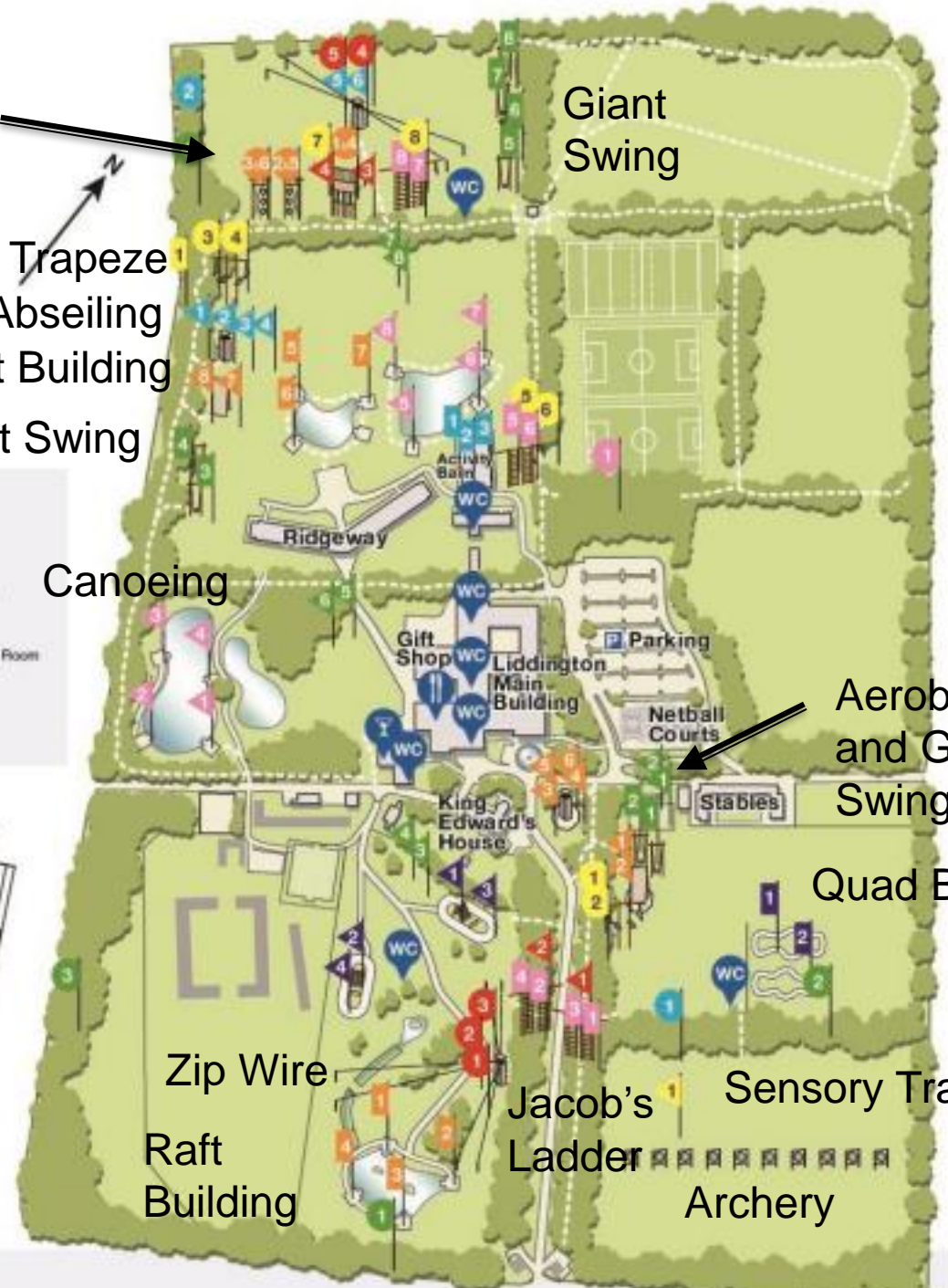

First day at PGL

Food

- Liddington has a canteen which caters for all dietary requirements.
- There are a wide range of food options and choices e.g. salads, soup, vegetables, dairy products etc.
- Please let us know what requirements your child will need on the medical forms and PGL staff will ensure that these are catered for accordingly.

Food

- At every meal there is water and squash available. Children will not be allowed hot drinks.
- There is a vegan option at every meal
- Sample menus can be seen at www.pgl.co.uk/menus
- Children eat together in the dining room with teachers and PGL staff.
- Children will be expected to clear away their own plates at the end of the meal and leave the dining room tidy.

Shop/free time

- There is a shop on site and children will be allowed to use it if they wish. There is a spending limit each day (£3+).
- Children will be given free time to play and relax with their friends, but we will expect them to be on time to wherever they need to be.

Other points

- Please be advised that children should bring sensible sized suitcases that they can move around on their own. Luggage should be as small as possible as it is always a challenge to fit everything on!
- No child is allowed to bring mobile phones with them.
- We discourage the children to bring excessive amounts of sweets.

Other points

- Medical and consent forms will be sent out in May 2026. These will need to be returned asap so that we can contact PGL with regards to allergies and medical requirements.
- There will be a medical session the week before we go where you can discuss and finalise medical needs for the week (medicines etc)
- Any queries or questions about the trip, please let us know.

Cost of trip

- The cost of the trip is £540 per child.
- The cost includes full board accommodation, travel to and from the centre, activity options, instruction and supervision from staff, use of equipment, evening entertainments and insurances
- If you would like your child to go, we would ask for an initial £40 deposit by the 01 May 2025, so that we can confirm our booking.
- The rest of the final cost will be requested in instalments of 10 payments of £50 due on the last day of each month, May – February.
- If you have any concerns about this, please speak to staff.

Payment plan

- We will be asking for the cost of the trip in instalments. We hope that this will reduce any stress about large payments. The instalments are:

ANY QUESTIONS?

Q) What if my child suffers from travel sickness?

A) Travel sickness is not the same as viral sickness, viral sickness will unfortunately need 48hrs absence from the trip. If your child is sick 2 days prior to the trip we will not be able to accommodate them on the coach. Please discuss all medication including travel medication prior to the trip. We can cater for all needs.

Q) What activities will my child be taking part in?

Q) What happens if a child doesn't want to do an activity?

A) Generally, they end up giving it a go but obviously we wouldn't force anyone to do something they don't want to. The children encourage each other to be brave to great effect

Q) Do the children get snacks during the day?

A) Food is plentiful and the meals are well catered for, please visit the website at PGL for details including how allergies are catered for.

ANY QUESTIONS?

Q) Is there a shop on site?

A) PGL recommend £5 per day but we suggest £10 for the trip only. There are sweets and gifts but £10 should be plenty.

Q) How often will there be photos?

A) We will provide photos when we can, but we are dependent upon 5G connectivity or WIFI and the time for a staff member to collect photos and update. We will contact the office daily via email as a minimum.

Q) Could there could be a Facebook group?

A) RC will look at the GDPR/Safeguarding situation before committing to this.

Q) Can adults have details of the whole cost of the trip?

A) RC will speak to the Governors within the Finance committee for GDPR authorisation. Payments will be set up via Arbor and the office will organise and communicate regarding this. We need a show of interest and the deposit paid in order to ensure we can afford this trip.

ANY QUESTIONS?

Q) What will the sleeping arrangements be? Will there be an adult nearby?

A) Every child will know an adult and be close to adults at night and staff will be aware of sleeping conditions. If you would like to discuss this in more detail, please contact the office team who will make sure we are aware beforehand.

Q) Which staff members will be going?

A) We cannot yet guarantee the staff yet, but the children will be aware of the staff and will have met them in advance
